

Guidelines for the tournament - Scandinavian Masters 2022

Overall principles: All teams will have at least 5 games during the weekend – actually most teams will have 6 games during the weekend. The winner of a match is found after 2 won sets - a possible third set is played till 15 (with +2 ballpoints).

Both days we will start the games at 9 am. Saturday the latest games are planned to start at 6 pm. **Please** be present and ready for playing on time – even also as referee be keen on executing the game to start on time. !!!

Female 15

Due to a high number of teams female 15 is divided into A- and B-tournaments.

Female 15A - 10 teams – Dalumhallerne

Is divided into 2 pools playing preliminary matches Saturday.

Rank 1-4: No 1+2 from the two pools will play semifinals plus finals.

Rank 5 till 7 will be found in a triangle with 2 pools rank 3 teams and best pool rank 4 above.

Rank 8-10 will be found in a triangle with the 3 teams not involved above.

Female 15B - 12 teams – Dalumhallerne

Is divided into 3 pools playing preliminary matches.

Rank 1-6: The two best rankings from each pool will form 2 new pool – both with 3 teams meeting in a triangle. Finally the two rank 1 from the triangle pools will play for the final rank 1. Similarly, the rank 2's will meet and the same goes for the rank 3's.

Rank 7-12: No 3 and 4 from the prelim pools will play for rank 7-12 using same game plan as for rank 1-6.

Female 17 – 14 teams – Hjalleshallen – updated Feb 27th

Is divided into 3 pools playing preliminary matches

Rank 1-6: The two best rankings from each pool will form 2 new pools – both with 3 teams meeting in a triangle. The winners from these 2 pools will play final, the 2's and 3' will play similarly for rank 3+4 and 5+6.

Rank 7-10: Rank 3 from the 3 preliminary pools and the best rank 4 will lead to two b-semifinals and b-finals.

Rank 11-14: The left back 4 teams will meet in c-semi finals and c-finals – 2 matches for all teams

Female 20 – 6 teams - Hunderupskolens hal

The 6 teams plays a round-robin competition.

Male 15 – 10 teams – Dalumhallerne

Is divided into 2 pools playing preliminary matches Saturday.

Rank 1-4: No 1+2 from the two pools will play semifinals plus finals.

Rank 5 till 7 will be found in a triangle with 2 pools rank 3 teams and best pool rank 4 above.

Rank 8-10 will be found in a triangle with the 3 teams not involved above.

Male 17 - 12 teams - Klostermark hallen – updated Mar. 3rd

Is divided into 3 pools playing preliminary matches.

Rank 1-6: The two best rankings from each pool will form 2 new pool – both with 3 teams meeting in a triangle. Finally the two rank 1 from the triangle pools will play for the final rank 1. Similarly, the rank 2's will meet and the same goes for the rank 3's.

Rank 7-12: No 3 and 4 from the prelim pools will play for rank 7-12 using same game plan as for rank 1-6.

Male 20 - 10 teams - Hunderupskolens hal

Is divided into 2 pools playing preliminary matches Saturday.

Rank 1-4: No 1+2 from the two pools will play semifinals plus finals.

Rank 5 till 7 will be found in a triangle with 2 pools rank 3 teams and best pool rank 4 above.

Rank 8-10 will be found in a triangle with the 3 teams not involved above.

Principles for scores and ranking in the pools

Winning a match will give 2 points for the winner and 0 for the loser.

Rankings in the pools is decided by:

1. Number of points
2. Won minus lost sets in total
3. Won minus lost balls in total
4. The result of the in-between match (team A vs team B)

The net:

Female: AGE 20: 2,24 m - AGE 17: 2,24 m - AGE 15: 2,15 m

Male: AGE 20: 2,43 m - AGE 17: 2,35 m - AGE 15: 2,24 m
